the identification of a live nymph or adult louse. These guidelines recommend an examination of wet hair lubricated with such products as a standard hair conditioner.

Head lice are parasitic insects called *Pediculus humanus capitis*. They only live on the heads of people. Life cycle. There are 3 forms of head lice: nits, nymphs, and adults. Nits

Head lice can be a nuisance but they have not been shown to spread disease. Personal hygiene or cleanliness in the home or school has nothing to do with getting head lice. Both the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the National Association of School Nurses (NASN) advocate that “no-nit” policies should be discontinued.

### **CDC - Lice - Head Lice - Schools**

Head lice and head lice nits are found almost exclusively on the scalp, particularly around and behind the ears and near the neckline at the back of the head. Head lice or head lice nits sometimes are found on the eyelashes or eyebrows but this is uncommon. Head lice hold tightly to hair with hook-like claws at the end of each of their six legs.

Ask a pharmacist for advice if you have tried wet combing for 17 days, but your child still has live head lice. They may recommend using medicated lotions and sprays. These kill head lice in all types of hair, and you can buy them from pharmacies, supermarkets or online. Head lice should die within a day.

Establish a Head Lice Control Standard Communicate your policy to your staff and teach them how to properly identify head lice and nits (lice eggs). The NPA's Critter Card presents a clear and realistic depiction of both lice and nits. Staff members should understand the rationale behind your head lice standard.

### **Child Care Provider's Guide To Controlling Head Lice ...**

It is prudent for children to be taught not to share personal items, such as combs, brushes, and hats, but one should not refuse to wear protective headgear because of fear of head lice. In environments where children are together, infested children should be treated promptly to minimize spread to others.

Head lice don't carry bacterial or viral infectious diseases. Over-the-counter and prescription medications are available to treat head lice. Follow treatment instructions carefully to rid your

2.4 Health education about head lice encourages parents/carers and children to: Prevent head lice by regular shampooing, conditioning and daily combing of the hair. Detect head lice using a fine tooth plastic or detector comb on a weekly basis. Treat head lice as soon as an infection becomes apparent.
