According to FindLaw, most states prohibit changing your name to escape debt, hide from criminal liability, or to commit a crime. You're also not allowed to change your name to an intentionally misleading name, such as that of a celebrity.

With a court order you can change your legal name on government-issued identification documents such as your driver's license, passport, and social security card. You will generally need a certified copy of the decree changing your name. If you want to change your name or that of a minor, click on the relevant section below to get the steps you must follow.

If you have changed your name with the Social Security Administration and received a new Social Security Card then file with your married name. If you have not made the change with Social Security yet, then file with your maiden name. 0

If you legally change your name because of marriage, divorce, court order or any other reason, you must tell Social Security so you can get a corrected card. You cannot apply for a card online. There is no charge for a Social Security card. This service is free.

How do I change or correct my name on my Social Security ...

If you need to apply for a name change, there are a couple of ways to do this depending on when your passport was issued. If it has been one year or less since your passport was issued and you can provide proof of the name change, then you can submit form DS-5504 to the address on the application. There is no fee for this service.

Travel with my passport in my maiden name and my marriage ...

After obtaining a court order granting a name change, you should update important identification records, including your driver's license or other state-issued identification, Social Security card, and your passport. If you changed your name after gender reassignment surgery or as a result of adoption, you can update your birth certificate.
