If a shareholder plaintiff recovers on a derivative claim, that recovery, like the claim itself, belongs to the corporation.⁴⁴Although the victorious shareholder may recover attorney fees and costs, any damages recovered belong to the entity.⁴⁵"A minority stockholder may sue because the corporations is under the control of the alleged wrongdoers, but he must sue in a representative capacity for the benefit of the corporation, and not for damages to him individually."⁴⁶
